Last evening I attended the first of 3 meetings of homeowners, in support of Klaus Radtke. It was attended by very intelligent people. The main presentation was by an attorney. It was clear and concise. This, in itself, was refreshing.

While Beta and other County people I have talked with, refuse to make comment on this controversial matter, it is OBVIOUS that it is a tempest in a LARGE teapot--30 thousand dollars or so to prosecute and a equal amount to defend. Both the County and Dr. Radtke have better ways to spend their money.

The July 26, 1982 memo from George Demos to Department Fire Chief King proves that Radtke was acting within authority. The Homeowner's Guide is an attractive, well composed, helpful brochure. The "flap" over its publication should be dropped immediately.

Subsequent to the July 26 memo, two orders from the Supervisors to Chief Bragdon, regarding the guide, were ignored. Now, Chief Bragdon should be given one more order--drop the inquisition. If he disobeys this, discharge him.

My copy of this letter, I am asking for a meeting with Supervisor Dana, as I understand that Bragdon currently reports to him. Your encouragement of this meeting will be appreciated.
